Dear Friends and Family,

The Elders and I are in agreement that it is time to allow for public (in-person) corporate worship. We realize our isolation, while necessary, has been trying and difficult in many ways. Going forward, we want to do everything to accommodate our need to gather for worship and enjoy closer fellowship, but with restrictions and recommendations in place.

We in no way want to endanger you, but sensibly come back together. If you feel unsafe in coming back to public worship, please do not feel bad about remaining at home for a time longer. Here are our thoughts about how our in-person assembly can and should happen:

We will meet beginning Sunday, June 7, 2020 at 9:30am for worship and then again for Adult Sunday School at 11:00am here at the church building. There will be no children's church for a while, but we are asking that families worship together upstairs. We will try to provide activities and ways to keep your children engaged.

Wednesday Bible Study at 7:00pm will not be held publically for the time being, but still on Facebook Live.

When you come to the church, we are asking you to use the Elm Street entrance that is our grade-level access bringing you into the foyer and giving you access to the personal lift if needed. **The two Center Street entrances will not be used for a time.** Also, the basement is not to be used during this transition.

As you come into the church building, **please allow a distance of at least 6 feet between yourself and other non-family members at all times.** We are asking everyone (unless there is a health reason) **bring and wear a protective mask** while walking around. Once you are seated, you may remove your mask if you wish.

Right inside the Elm Street entrance, we will have **hand sanitizer** on a table in the foyer that **must be used by everyone including children** before going upstairs for services. There will also be a table with hand sanitizer upstairs that we would like for you to use before being seated, and then again before you leave the sanctuary for any reason.

There will be a table up in Texas where you can pickup your **individually-packaged communion** and also leave an offering or tithe for the ongoing work of the church.

We plan on using the main sanctuary for morning worship seating only. **We plan on using Texas for Adult Sunday School only.** We will make adjustments as we need, but for now we ask you to do this to prevent unnecessary potential contamination of our seating areas.

Thank you in advance for your help and cooperation in all of this. If you have questions, please do not hesitate to ask the elders or myself. We wish everyone to come back together safely. **Please let us know if you intend to be here on June 7th.**
